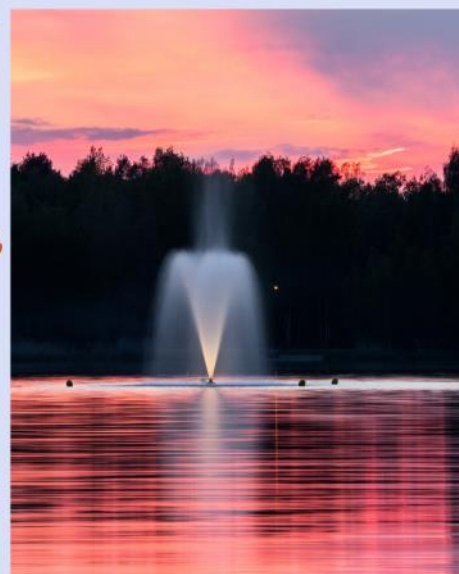

Kings Point Tram services available to every resident!

Masks are optional on trams.

REMINDER!

We are now allowing guests at this time.

If using the tram from the clubhouse, transportation office MUST be notified before quarter-past the hour and you must be present in the foyer by 25 minutes past the hour.

Passengers must be waiting in front of their homes ready to board the tram upon arrival.

Drivers are prohibited from assisting passengers when boarding and exiting the vehicle. If a resident has difficulty boarding or exiting the vehicle, a Kings Point resident or lessee escort must accompany and assist the resident. Drivers are not permitted to assist passengers with groceries, shopping bags or other packages ***Two Bag Maximum*** and walkers.

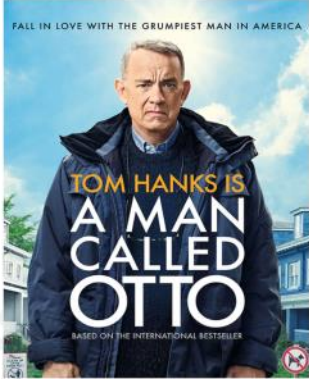

Golf Cart Safety

You may only drive a golf cart on golf courses or roadways that are designated for golf carts. These roads will be marked with appropriate signs.

- A golf cart must not be driven by anyone under the age of 14 on public roads or streets.
- A golf cart must only be operated during the hours between sunrise and sunset, unless the local government allows them to be driven outside of those hours (additional equipment is required for night driving.)*
- Golf carts may be operated only on state roads that have a posted speed limit of 30 MPH or less.
- You may cross state roads if the posted speed limit is 45 MPH or less and only at an intersection with a traffic control device.
- You can drive a golf cart on a sidewalk only if it is at least 5 feet wide. You must yield to pedestrians.
- You can drive a golf cart on a two lane county road in a city that designates it may be used for golf carts.
- All local and state traffic laws must be obeyed, including yielding the right-of-way.

Out of all the foregoing, the following are major contributors to serious accidents:

1. Making turns **without looking** and signaling.
2. Backing up without waiting and warning.
3. Entering traffic lanes **without stopping**.
4. Speeding beyond the ability to maintain control.
5. Driving in a manner dangerous to passengers
6. Traveling in an improper traffic lane — **stay to the right**.
7. Driving after dark without headlights or taillights.
8. Operating an improperly maintained cart.

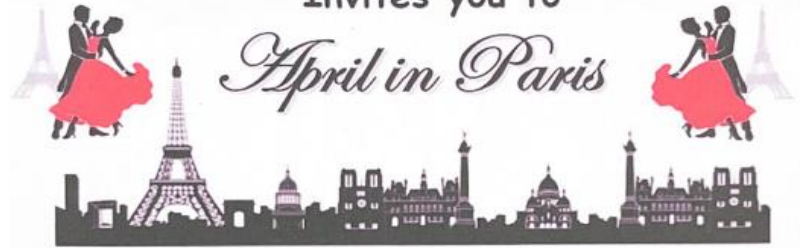

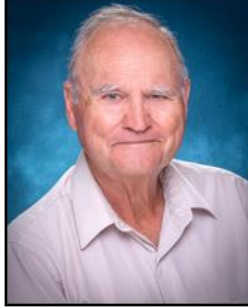
