



Kings Point Tram services available to every resident!

Masks are optional on trams.

REMINDER!

We are now allowing guests.

If using the tram from the clubhouse, transportation office MUST be notified before quarter-past the hour and you must be present in the foyer by 25 minutes past the hour.

Passengers must be waiting in front of their homes ready to board the tram upon arrival.

Drivers are prohibited from assisting passengers when boarding and exiting the vehicle. If a resident has difficulty boarding or exiting the vehicle, a Kings Point resident or lessee escort must accompany and assist the resident. Drivers are not permitted to assist passengers with groceries, shopping bags or other packages *Two Bag Maximum* and walkers.

AQUA BATA: full body workout using time intervals and various types of equipment.

AQUA IN MOTION: A moderate water workout using a loop band and then gentle exercises to improve strength, endurance, and flexibility.

AQUANAUTICS: A total body water workout using various types of exercises.

AQUA RESISTANCE: Focuses on upper and lower body strength and endurance by using the water, wall, noddle and water weights as resistance.

DEEP WATER: An intense workout where feet are off the bottom of the pool in any depth of water that one is comfortable with.

DOUBLE NOODLE: Vigorous workout for the entire body using two noodles and no weights.

STRETCH & FLOW WATER: A thorough stretch from neck to toe.

<u>WATER WALKING</u>: Resistance bands for the upper body while moving using various types of walking and at different intensities. Also includes stretching.

WET WORKOUT: A foundational, no-equipment, total body workout of cardio, strength and mobility.

Reminders About Cold Weather Policies For Water Classes:

If the current temperature of the air at the pool is **73** degrees or lower up to 15 minutes before the class is scheduled to start then the class may utilize the indoor pool. If the temperature is close to the designated temperature but the wind is above 10mph the class may utilize the indoor pool. *The instructor will be responsible for making the final judgement call for classes to move inside or remain outdoors.

Mats will not be provided for any class.


