As the holiday season approaches, we want to remind everyone to stay vigilant against scammers. Here are a few simple tips to help protect yourself:

Be Cautious:

- Scammers use phone calls, texts, emails, and social media to trick you into sharing personal information or sending money.

They might pretend to be someone you know or a trusted organization.

What You Should Do:

- Learn to recognize common scams and fraud signs.

Keep your computer software, browsers, and apps up to date.

What to Avoid:

- Don't reuse passwords; create strong, unique passwords for each account.
- Never share passwords with others.

Avoid sharing personal info on unencrypted websites; look for "https" in the URL for secure sites.

If you suspect identity theft or an online scam, you can report scams to your bank or the FTC (Federal Trade Commission) at 1-877-382-4357.

*Kings Point Tram services
available to every resident!*

Guests with valid guest passes are permitted on the tram. If using the tram from the clubhouse, transportation office MUST be notified before quarter -past the hour and you must be present in the foyer by 25 minutes past the hour.

Passengers must be waiting in front of their homes ready to board the tram upon arrival.

Drivers are prohibited from assisting passengers when boarding and exiting the vehicle. If a resident has difficulty boarding or exiting the vehicle, a Kings Point resident or lessee escort must accompany and assist the resident. Drivers are not permitted to assist passengers with groceries, shopping bags or other packages ***Two Bag Maximum*** and walkers.
